ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT AMENDMENT NO. 38 - 2024 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - NOVEMBER 2024

SECTION I: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - INFRASTRUCTURE

Rural Internet Connectivity

Scope: This project will create public/private partnerships between St. Tammany Parish Government and Internet Service Providers. These partnerships will utilize ARPA funds and require a private contribution of at least 50% to provide broadband internet access to the highest priority zones defined by the April 2023 Broadband Solution Report provided by Foresite Group.

Status: With this additional funding, along with remaining funding, we will solicit proposals via RFP for internet service providers to install infrastructure to provide broadband internet connectivity to the citizens residing in Fiberhoods 6-A, 1-A, 2-A, 2-B, 4-C, and 4-D. These areas have been identified as part of the highest priority and underserved areas in St. Tammany Parish.

- (2-A) Hwy 1129, N. of Lee Rd.
- (2-B) Lee Rd. Area where Hwy 1129 meets Lee Rd.
- (4-C) Area directly west of Money Hill near Hwy 40, Allen Rd., & Hwy 21
- (4-D) East side of Lee Rd., adjacent to 2-B, near Pat O'Brien Rd.
- (6-A) Talisheek
