## SECTION II: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - FACILITIES AND TECHNOLOGY

## Fishing Pier-Hurricane Ida

Scope: Assess the fishing pier, parking lot and associated equipment for repairs due to Hurricane Ida, develop construction documents for the repair and mitigation, and complete repairs and mitigation features.

The damage assessment as prepared by Meyer Engineers was submitted to FEMA in order to request public assistance under Disaster 4611 (Hurricane Ida) for the repairs and mitigation of the St. Tammany Parish Fishing Pier and related facilities. FEMA has obligated a project based on the authorized repairs and mitigation measures, including design costs for the fishing pier structure, parking lot, and associated equipment (Total FEMA funds \$2,158,047).

The local cost share of 10% and any ineligible FEMA expenditures for the pier repair will be funded from available grant funds from the BP Tourism Grant of \$338,330.03.

Status: Meyer Engineers completed their damage assessment and mitigation recommendations for the St. Tammany Fishing Pier Hurricane Ida damage in February 2023. FEMA approved the repairs and mitigation features in June 2024. Meyer Engineers was contracted for the Phase 2 final design. Meyer estimates the construction documents will be complete in June 2025. The complexity of the infrastructure associated with the pier structure and the uncertainty of mitigation design prevented any preliminary work from being performed on the pier until after FEMA approved the mitigation features. Construction for the repairs and mitigation will take about a year to complete.

Insurance proceeds and Economic Development Hotel/Motel Taxes are being reallocated to fund the pier bathroom and office building repairs. Project still in development.
