Harrison Ave. Urban Ponds	Allocate available funds from Drainage Service Area Impact Fees Capital Project fund 263-4664 to investigate and design urban stormwater ponds on vacant subdivision lots in Tammany Hills, Red Gap Acres, and other areas off of Harrison Ave. as a possible means of mitigation of upstream development.
Little Bayou Castine Drainage	Allocate available funds for channel improvements to Little Bayou Castine, including culvert improvements to efficiently convey water and a pond at the end of Nelson St. Total project budget is \$2,811,427.00 as follows: \$28,890.00 from VDA funds for The Fountains Subdivision, \$3,020.00 from Drainage Basins funds, \$1,167,330.00 from Drainage Service Area Impact Fees Capital Projects fund 263-4664, and \$1,612,187.00 from Capital Project fund 201-4606 Drainage - Parishwide.
Military Rd. Urban Ponds	Allocate available funds from Drainage Service Area Impact Fees Capital Project fund 263-4664 to investigate and design urban stormwater ponds on vacant subdivision lots in Cross Gates, Willow Wood, Frenchman, and French Branch subdivisions as a possible means of mitigation of upstream development.
Pruden Creek Drainage	Allocate available funds for the collection of survey data to evaluate the condition and functionality of a lateral ditch draining into Pruden Creek. Total project budget is \$75,000.00 as follows: \$20,000.00 from VDA funds for Lake Ramsey, \$27,000.00 from VDA funds for Penn Mill Lakes, and \$28,000.00 from Capital Projects fund 201-4606 Drainage - Parishwide.
Waldheim Property	Allocate available funds to acquire property for the prupose of maintaining parishwide drainage. Site may be utilized for the storage of materials including debris, dirt, mud, and vegetation removed from Parish right-of-ways and waterways. Site may also be utilized for the storage of equipment and to facilitate Parishwide drainage projects.
