ORDINANCE LEVYING INCREASED MILLAGE RATES FOR THE YEAR 2024 FOR ANIMAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter for St. Tammany Parish Section 2-11 (3) requires an ordinance to levy taxes, assessments and charges.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that in a public meeting held on September 5, 2024, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the Parish Council voted to increase the millage rates, but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rates, on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2024, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rates are:

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ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT MILLAGE ORDINANCE – JULY 2024

The millage for Animal Services is proposed to be rolled forward. A roll forward is when the millage rate is increased after reassessment from the adjusted maximum millage rate to a rate not in excess of the "prior year's maximum." The roll forward would be to the maximum authorized levy which is the same as the 2023 levy.

The Animal Shelter millage is for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining, and operating an animal shelter for the Parish, including necessary equipment and facilities therefore. The authorized levy period is from 2019-2028. This millage is vital to support the life-saving efforts and to maintain the no-kill status for Animal Services. As shown on page 3 of the 2024 Operating Budget Ordinance, operating expenditures exceed revenues by approximately \$275,345. Therefore, funds from the rollforward would be used to decrease the reliance on the fund balance for annual operations.

The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next tax year is \$3,103,226, an increase of \$217,226. These amounts are presented gross before deductions for pension assessment fees and uncollectible accounts. The estimated cost to a home valued at \$300,000 is \$22.50, an increase of \$1.58.

However, the millage for the St. Tammany Parish Coroner's Office is proposed to be decreased by .42 mills, which will result in no overall additional cost to taxpayers from these actions.
