ORDINANCE LEVYING INCREASED MILLAGE RATES FOR THE YEAR 2024 FOR DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter for St. Tammany Parish Section 2-11 (3) requires an ordinance to levy taxes, assessments and charges.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that in a public meeting held on September 5, 2024, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the Parish Council voted to increase the millage rates, but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rates, on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2024, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rates are:

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ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT MILLAGE ORDINANCE – JULY 2024

The millage for Drainage Maintenance is proposed to be rolled forward. A roll forward is when the millage rate is increased after reassessment from the adjusted maximum millage rate to a rate not in excess of the "prior year's maximum." The roll forward would be to the maximum authorized levy which is the same as the 2023 levy.

The Drainage Maintenance millage is for the purpose of improving, maintaining and constructing, bulk heading and bridging drainage ways, drainage ditches, drainage channels, and drainage canals within the Parish and related non-capital expenditures. The authorized levy period is from 2021-2030. This millage is crucial to mitigating flood risk and providing investments to our drainage systems. As shown on page 2 of the 2024 Operating Budget Ordinance, the net revenues after collection fees and assessments are approximately \$4,311,378 and operating expenditures are \$987,300, with available revenue over expenditures of \$3,324,078 for capital improvements. Page 18 of the 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Plan, exhibit to the 2024 Capital Budget Ordinance, shows over \$39 million in drainage projects. Therefore, funds from the rollforward would aid in financing these projects.

The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next tax year is \$5,244,451, an increase of \$403,419. These amounts are presented gross before deductions for pension assessment fees and uncollectible accounts. The estimated cost to a home valued at \$300,000 is \$38.03, an increase of \$2.93.

However, the millage for the St. Tammany Parish Coroner's Office is proposed to be decreased by .42 mills, which will result in no overall additional cost to taxpayers from these actions.
