### 141 - GRANTS-COASTAL

F2408 TREAS-Restore Act

Grant amount from trust fund allocation as of April 2024 not yet proposed to a project. The Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities, and Revived Economies of the Gulf Coast States Act (RESTORE Act) established the Gulf Coast Restoration Trust Fund under which 80% of all administrative and civil penalties paid after July 6, 2012, by responsible parties pursuant to a court order, negotiated settlement, or other instrument, under section 311 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act in connection with the Deepwater Horizon oil spill are deposited. Under the Act, amounts in the Trust Fund will be available for programs, projects, and activities that restore and protect the environment and economy of the Gulf Coast region. 35% percent of the penalties paid into the Trust Fund are set aside for the Direct Component, which is administered by Treasury for eligible activities proposed by the States of Alabama, Mississippi, Texas, Louisiana, 20 Louisiana parishes, and 23 Florida counties.

See Companion Ordinance to amend the 2024 Capital Improvement Budget and Capital Assets - Amendment No. 29 Coastal Restoration Capital Projects, which proposes to obligate \$3,014,612.49 to the Material of Opportunity Capital Project.

Grant award received to plan, design, and curate a multicultural exhibit to document the history and heritage of Camp Salmen Nature Park. The grant is funding \$9,600 and requires a 50% match. \$7,159 is to be funded by salaries from the Grants Department in the General Fund, and \$2,441 is to be funded by available grant funds from prior years from the Commission on Cultural Affairs.
