In accordance with Ordinance Series No. 14-3234, St. Tammany Parish Government established a Tree Bank Program, which is intended to maintain the canopy balance of protected trees in St. Tammany Parish. The program involves payment into a Parish escrow account for trees affected by new development when all other mitigation options are not feasible. The program revenue will be utilized to fund landscape projects within public rights-of-way with preference given to water quality and erosion control projects.
