ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING" ZONE ON ST. TAMMANY PARISH TRACE ROW (WARD 3, DISTRICT 2)

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and welfare of the citizens of St. Tammany Parish; and

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: A "No Parking" zone is hereby established on St. Tammany Parish Trace ROW beginning on east side of the rear entrance to Bogue Falaya Towers, going west for a distance of 100 feet for the entire ROW.

The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signage at the location.

REPEAL: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.

Administrative Department: Public Works

PURPOSE: To establish a “NO PARKING” zone on the St. Tammany Parish Trace right-of-way, beginning on the east side of the rear entrance to Bogue Falaya Towers. This action is requested and coordinated with the City of Covington, the residents of Bogue Falaya Towers, and the District #2 Councilmember to address nuisance parking that obstructs dumpster access for residents and garbage collection services.
