ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET AND CAPITAL ASSETS - AMENDMENT NO. 7
DEVELOPMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government has prepared a capital improvement budget and capital asset list in accordance with the Home Rule Charter.

AMENDMENT NO. 7 - 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - APRIL 2026

SECTION I: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - INFRASTRUCTURE (ROADS, BRIDGES, DRAINAGE, AND UTILITIES)

Mandeville Lakefront Wetlands Restoration

Scope: Project will construct a one-acre rock berm along the shoreline and 4.75 acres of marsh platform using dredged and supplemental material, while re-routing urban stormwater through a 1,100-foot diversion canal. The project aims to restore wetland hydrology, improve water quality, protect the cypress swamp, enhance fish and wildlife habitat, and provide community recreational and educational benefits. The City of Mandeville will manage construction, permitting, and contractor coordination, with a Parish Match from Coastal Protection & Restoration Authority (CPRA), aligning with broader Lake Pontchartrain restoration goals.

Status: Project to take approximately 12 months.

Wetlands Plan, Ph.3

Scope: Project will include a focused review of Parish ordinances, policies, jurisdictional mapping, and critical drainage area buffers to assess consistency and implementation under the post-Sackett regulatory framework. The effort will evaluate alignment with applicable Louisiana and federal water-related programs, including anticipated Waters of the United States (WOTUS) rulemaking expected during the 2025-2026 timeframe.

In addition, project will assess zoning and land-use policies to better direct development away from environmentally sensitive areas while maintaining appropriate growth capacity. Existing wetland-related permitting programs will be reviewed, and a Parish-specific mitigation program will be developed to address regulatory gaps and support responsible development.

Program Management, Ph.2

Scope: St. Tammany Parish Government will advance the \$5.9 billion Coastal Storm and Flood Risk Management Project and the Lake Pontchartrain Storm Surge Reduction Project. The scope includes coordinating federal, state, and local efforts, conducting engineering and design, evaluating levees, floodwalls, drainage, and nonstructural measures, engaging stakeholders, and ensuring alignment with funding, permitting, and regulatory requirements. These efforts will guide the projects from planning to implementation, support local flood protection initiatives, and maintain program continuity.
