A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN ROAD
LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 9 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE
OF LOUISIANA, ON SATURDAY, MAY 16, 2026, TO AUTHORIZE THE
LEVY OF A SERVICE CHARGE THEREIN.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana
(the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Road Lighting District No. 9 of
the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), that:

SECTION 1. Canvass. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public
session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in Road
Lighting District No. 9 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, on SATURDAY, MAY 16,
2026, to authorize the levy of a service charge therein, and said Governing Authority does further
proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of the special election.

SECTION 2. Election Results. According to the official certified tabulation of votes cast at
said Elections, there was a total of **488** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Proposition and a total of
1,055 votes cast **AGAINST** the Proposition, resulting in a majority of **567** votes cast **AGAINST** the
Proposition. The Proposition was therefore duly **DEFEATED** by a majority of the votes cast by the
qualified electors voting at the Election.

SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Result. The results of said election shall be
promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law, after receipt from the Secretary of
State's office of the actual costs of the election, as required by §18:1292 of the Louisiana Revised
Statutes of 1950, as amended.

SECTION 4. Declaration. The foregoing results of the Election are hereby declared by this
Governing Authority and shall be published as required by law.

SECTION 5. Procès Verbal. A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of the Election
shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton
Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy thereof shall be
forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St.
Tammany, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy
thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

PROCÈS VERBAL OF THE CANVASS OF THE VOTES CAST AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 9 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, ON SATURDAY, MAY 16, 2026.

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Thursday, June 4, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., at its regular meeting place, the Council Chambers of the Parish Government Complex, 21490 Koop Drive, Mandeville, Louisiana, the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Road Lighting District No. 9 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), and being the authority ordering the special election held therein on Saturday, May 16, 2026, with a quorum being present, did examine the official certified tabulations of votes cast at the said election, and did examine and canvass the returns of the said election, there having been submitted at said election the following proposition, to wit:

ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 9 PROPOSITION
(SERVICE CHARGE)

Shall Road Lighting District No. 9 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to assess an annual service charge of \$50 per structure or lot (an estimated \$123,300 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2026 and ending with the year 2035, to persons occupying residential and non-residential structures and persons owning unoccupied structures located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District and to persons owning lots located wholly or partly within the District upon which no structure is located for the purpose of paying utility charges for road lighting and maintaining and operating road lighting facilities and equipment within the District?

There was found by said count and canvass that there was a total of **488** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Proposition and a total of **1,055** votes cast **AGAINST** the Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and it was further found and determined that there was a majority of **567** votes cast **AGAINST** the Proposition as hereinabove set forth.

Therefore, the Governing Authority did declare and proclaim and does hereby declare and proclaim in open and public session that the Proposition as hereinabove set forth was duly **DEFEATED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the said special election.
