A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTIONS HELD IN (I) THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TO AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF A SPECIAL TAX THEREIN,(II) SALES TAX DISTRICT NO. THREE OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TO AUTHORIZE THE EXTENSION AND REDEDICATION OF A SALES AND USE TAX THEREIN AND (III) ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 10 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF A SERVICE CHARGE THEREIN, ON SATURDAY, MARCH 29, 2025.

BE IT RESOLVED by Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of (i) the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (ii) Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana and (iii) Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish and Districts"), that:

SECTION 1. <u>Canvass.</u> This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special elections held on Saturday, March 29, 2025 (the "Elections"), in (i) the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, to authorize the renewal of a special tax therein,(ii) Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, to authorize the extension and rededication of a sales and use tax therein and (iii) Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, to authorize the levy of a service charge therein pursuant to the following propositions (the "Propositions"):

ST. TAMMANY PARISHWIDE PROPOSITION (LIBRARY MILLAGE CONTINUATION)

Shall the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), continue to levy a special tax of 4.35 mills (the "Tax") on all property subject to taxation in the Parish (an estimated \$13,510,265 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of 15 years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2039, for the purpose of constructing, acquiring, improving, maintaining and/or operating public library facilities, furnishings and equipment, and otherwise supporting the public library system in the Parish?

SALES TAX DISTRICT NO. THREE PROPOSITION (SALES TAX REDEDICATION)

Shall Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy its 2% sales and use tax (the "Tax") (an estimated \$88,948,127 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for an additional period of 25 years commencing December 1, 2031, with the proceeds of the Tax heretofore or hereafter collected to continue to be used for the purposes authorized at an election held on July 16, 2005 (including funding roads, bridges and drainage infrastructure) and for the additional purpose of paying expenses of the offices of the Criminal Division of the District Attorney and the Judges of the 22nd Judicial District Court, as well as expenses of the Justice Center, that benefit the residents of the District, provided that any revenues of the Tax expended for such additional purpose in any year may not exceed 17% of the proceeds of the Tax budgeted for that year?

ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 10 PROPOSITION (SERVICE CHARGE)

Shall Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to assess an annual service charge of \$80 per structure or lot (an estimated \$2,560 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2034, to persons occupying residential and non-residential structures and persons owning unoccupied structures located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District and to persons owning lots located wholly or partly within the District upon which no structure is located for the purpose of paying utility charges for road lighting and maintaining and operating road lighting facilities and equipment within the District?

This Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns of the Elections thereof.

SECTION 2. <u>Election Results.</u> According to the official certified tabulation of votes cast at said Elections,

- (i) there was a total of **23,194** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Parishwide Proposition and a total of **19,068** votes cast **AGAINST** the Parishwide Proposition, resulting in a majority of **4,126** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Parishwide Proposition;
- (ii) there was a total of **16,241** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition and a total of **17,572** votes cast **AGAINST** the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition, resulting in a majority of **1,331** votes cast **AGAINST** the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition; and
- (iii) there was a total of **19** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition and a total of **7** votes cast **AGAINST** the Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition, resulting in a majority of **12** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition.

The Parishwide Proposition and Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition were therefore duly **CARRIED** and Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition was therefore duly **DEFEATED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the Elections.

- SECTION 3. <u>Promulgation of Election Result.</u> The results of said elections shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law, after receipt from the Secretary of State's office of the actual costs of the elections, as required by §18:1292 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended.
- SECTION 4. <u>Declaration.</u> The foregoing results of the Elections are hereby declared by this Governing Authority and shall be published as required by law.
- SECTION 5. <u>Procès Verbal.</u> A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of the Elections shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in her office; another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Thursday, May 1, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., at its regular meeting place, the Council Chambers of the Parish Government Complex, 21490 Koop Drive, Mandeville, Louisiana, the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of (i) the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (ii) Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana and (iii) Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish and Districts"), and being the authority ordering the special elections held therein on Saturday, March 29, 2025, with a quorum of the Governing Authority present and did, in open and public session, examine the official certified tabulations of votes cast at the said elections, and did examine and canvass the returns of the said elections, there having been submitted at said elections the following propositions, to wit:

Shall the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), continue to levy a special tax of 4.35 mills (the "Tax") on all property subject to taxation in the Parish (an estimated \$13,510,265 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of 15 years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2039, for the purpose of constructing, acquiring, improving, maintaining and/or operating public library facilities, furnishings and equipment, and otherwise supporting the public library system in the Parish?

SALES TAX DISTRICT NO. THREE PROPOSITION (SALES TAX REDEDICATION)

Shall Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy its 2% sales and use tax (the "Tax") (an estimated \$88,948,127 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for an additional period of 25 years commencing December 1, 2031, with the proceeds of the Tax heretofore or hereafter collected to continue to be used for the purposes authorized at an election held on July 16, 2005 (including funding roads, bridges and drainage infrastructure) and for the additional purpose of paying expenses of the offices of the Criminal Division of the District Attorney and the Judges of the 22nd Judicial District Court, as well as expenses of the Justice Center, that benefit the residents of the District, provided that any revenues of the Tax expended for such additional purpose in any year may not exceed 17% of the proceeds of the Tax budgeted for that year?

ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 10 PROPOSITION (SERVICE CHARGE)

Shall Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to assess an annual service charge of \$80 per structure or lot (an estimated \$2,560 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2034, to persons occupying residential and non-residential structures and persons owning unoccupied structures located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District and to persons owning lots located wholly or partly within the District upon which no structure is located for the purpose of paying utility charges for road lighting and maintaining and operating road lighting facilities and equipment within the District?

There was found by said count and canvass that (i) there was a total of 23,194 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Parishwide Proposition and a total of 19,068 votes cast AGAINST the Parishwide Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and it was further found and determined that there was a majority of 4,126 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Parishwide Proposition as hereinabove set forth, (ii) there was a total of 16,241 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition and a total of 17,572 votes cast AGAINST the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and it was further found and determined that there was a majority of 1,331 votes cast AGAINST the Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition as hereinabove set forth, and (iii) there was a total of 19 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and it was further found and determined that there was a majority of 12 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition as hereinabove set forth.

Therefore, the Governing Authority did declare and proclaim and does hereby declare and proclaim in open and public session that the Parishwide Proposition and Road Lighting District No. 10 Proposition as hereinabove set forth were duly **CARRIED** and Sales Tax District No. Three Proposition as hereinabove set forth was duly **DEFEATED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the said special elections held in the Parish and Districts on Saturday, March 29, 2025.
