# ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT AMENDMENT NO. 19 - 2024 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - APRIL 2024

#### SECTION I: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - INFRASTRUCTURE (ROADS, BRIDGES, DRAINAGE, AND UTILITIES)

#### CAPITAL PROJECTS - 222-4001 - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - PLANNING

#### LA3241 Corridor Traffic Analysis

Scope: St. Tammany Parish (STP) is preparing a land use and transportation study for the area along the LA Highway 3241 corridor. The LA Highway 435 corridor to be reviewed is approximately 20 miles between I-12 and Bush. The capacity projects are being implemented in phases and STP should develop highway related strategies and corridor planning accommodating forecasted growth in the area. The need for the analysis results from construction of a new state highway that will result in population growth and development in this area of St. Tammany. The LA Highway 3241 project will provide an alternative north-south connection that will reduce congestion and delays for those traveling from northern St. Tammany Parish and Washington Parish to I-12. The proposed highway would increase safety by reducing the amount of traffic and congestion on existing routes (LA41 and LA21/LA59/US190).

Segment 2—Shortly after beginning the study, the need to expand the project limits to include LA Highway 434 (between I-12 and US190) and US190 (between Pugh Rd. and N. Tranquility Rd.) became apparent. The subject portions of LA434 and US190 are significantly more developed than the LA3241 corridor, also creating a more urgent need for zoning amendments to implement recommendations. However, the opening of a new roadway will open up land for development and access management and corridor planning are needed.

Status: The analysis is ongoing and will continue with the funding of Segment 2, which will take approximately 8 months.
