City of Sumas Council Meeting Minutes of October 25, 2021

The Sumas City Council met on October 25, 2021 with all councilmembers present, besides Josh Clawson. The minutes of October 11, 2021 meeting were presented and approved.

Mayor Christensen presented the Sub-Recipient Agreement between Whatcom County Sheriff's Office & City of Sumas. Daniel DeBruin, Police Chief, explained this is a sub-grant of the US Department of Homeland Security and Federal Emergency Management Agency for the Stonegarden Program managed by the Whatcom County Sheriff's Office. Jennifer Bell, Finance Director advised the council, Tully McConnell and Sunny Aulakh are at their anniversary for a step increase. Deborah Morgan made a motion to approve Tully McConnell's salary increase to Step 4, Rich Postma seconded, all were in favor the motion carried. Jennifer Bell advised that there will be a couple public hearings in November for the 2022 Preliminary Budget.
