**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUTTER CREEK**  
**RECERTIFYING THE SSMP KEEPING THE CITY IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATEWIDE**  
**GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS –**  
**WQO No. 2006-0003-DWQ (SSS WDR) MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM ORDER**  
**NO. 2013-0058-EXEC.**

**WHEREAS**, this Sanitary Sewer Systems Plan (SSMP) was updated July 20, 2026, and

**WHEREAS**, this SSMP will be used to efficiently maintain and improve the condition of the City's sewer collection system, minimize the number and impacts of sanitary sewer overflows (SSO)'s minimize inflow and infiltration (I&I), and provide adequate sewer collection system capacity for future growth manage, operate and maintain all portions of the City's wastewater collection system, and

**WHEREAS**, this plan conforms to the State Water Resources Control Board Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 2006-0003-DWQ, and

**WHEREAS**, this WQMP provides the framework to prepare a Fats, Oil, and Grease public education and outreach program within the next 6-months, and

**WHEREAS**, this WQMP is consistent with and supplemental to the City of Sutter Creek's Overflow Emergency Response Plan, Element 6 of its SSMP.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby recertifies the SSMP, keeping the City in compliance with statewide general waste discharge requirements for sanitary sewer systems and authorizes the Public Works Director, acting as the Legally Responsible Official (LRO) , to electronically certify and submit the final document to the State Water Resources Control Board's CIWQS database.
