**SUBJECT:** ADOPTION OF UPDATED LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Pass the resolution adopting the 2025 Updated Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) in its entirety including appendices and Annex.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the end of 2024 and during 2025, Dan LaFontaine and I attended a series of meetings led by the county and the county's consultant to identify hazards and potential mitigations. The result of that work is before you tonight, an updated local hazard mitigation plan compliant with AB2140 (which would enable the city to qualify for additional funding in the event of an emergency).

**DISCUSSION:**

During these meetings we identified threats and projects relevant to the City of Sutter Creek. Details specific to Sutter Creek can be found in Annex E.

The Council must adopt the LHMP and we must also update the Safety Element of the General Plan to refer to the updated plan. The updated Safety Element will go to planning commission, and then come back to you with updated linking to this updated plan.
