

RESOLUTION NO. 25-26-XX

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUTTER CREEK
ADOPTING THE 2025 UPDATED LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS the City of Sutter Creek recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the County; and

WHEREAS the City of Sutter Creek has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the County of Amador and City of Sutter Creek from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Sutter Creek City Council demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation -Plan;-and

WHEREAS the Sutter Creek City Council seeking FEMA approval of hazard mitigation plan desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan by reference into the Safety Element of the General Plan in accordance with the requirements of AB 2140; and.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sutter Creek as follows:

The Amador County Board of Supervisors adopts the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan. While content related to the County of Amador may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the County of Amador to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of Amador adopts the 2025 Amador County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan by reference into the safety element of their general plan in accordance with the requirements of AB 2140; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Amador County Board of Supervisors will submit this adoption resolution to the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA Region IX officials to enable the plan's final approval in accordance with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and to establish conformance with the requirement of AB 2140.
