



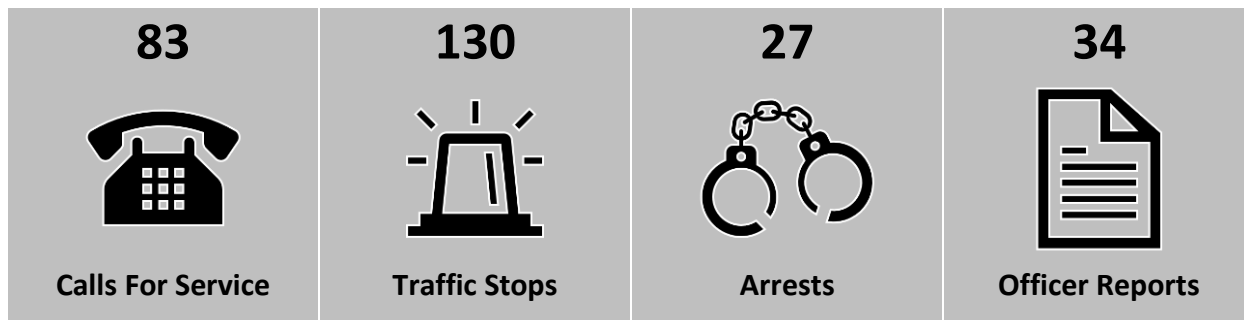

During a late-night car stop, SCPD located a suspect who was in possession of multiple credit cards belonging to residents. He was booked into the county jail for possession of methamphetamine and charges related to the stolen credit cards.

During the early morning hours of March 1st, an SCPD officer observed two people loitering around a business. The officer, aware that one of the people was on supervised release and subject to search, contacted them and conducted a search. He was found to be in possession of over two grams of methamphetamine. He was taken into custody and booked into the county jail,
