## City Overview

- Angels Camp is a gold county town located in Calaveras County.
- Population: 3,896
- Size: 3.6 sq. miles
- Most residents work within the city or in neighboring areas like Arnold and San Andres.
- The local economy relies heavily on tourism and its associated industries, including hospitality, retail, and dining.

## Police Department

- Angels Camp Police Department works alongside the Calaveras Sheriff's Department and San Andres CHP for law enforcement in Angels Camp.
- Total crime rate is 14.8 - 12.92 property crime rate & 1.88 violent crime rate.
- In 2023, police made 794 traffic stops.
- The department has 9 personnel.

## Police Special Revenues

- The Angels Camp Police Department serves as the County Parking Enforcement Authority and generates revenues from parking citations.
- The department also received state funding from the CA Highway Patrol for the 2024-25 fiscal year as a result of Proposition 64, the Control, Regulate, and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act, which they can use for law enforcement purposes.

## Partnerships

- The City of Angels Camp contracts dispatch services with the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office.
- The Angels Camp Police Department is a member of the Calaveras County Multi-Agency Coordinating Group (MAC), a management team responsible for responding to and managing emergency events; some other member agencies include the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office, CalTrans, CA Highway Patrol, and the U.S. Forest Service. MAC helps optimize limited resources, sets objections for emergency operations within Calaveras County, and makes final decisions relative to the preceding plans.
