

**RESOLUTION 2026-R6 IN SUPPORT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFETY PROJECTS
AND INITIATIVES ALONG NC 24 (W. CORBETT AVENUE)**

WHEREAS, the Town of Swansboro is committed to promoting safety, mobility, and overall quality of life for residents, visitors, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Swansboro, in coordination with the Jacksonville Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (JUMPO), North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), and regional partners, has identified key transportation safety and operational improvement needs along the NC 24 (W. Corbett Avenue) corridor within the town limits; and

WHEREAS, proposed safety improvements include installation of a High-Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) pedestrian-activated traffic beacon at the intersection of NC 24 (W. Corbett Avenue) and Front Street to enhance pedestrian safety while maintaining efficient vehicular traffic flow; and

WHEREAS, proposed improvements also include the installation of a Right-In/Right-Out (RIRO) driveway configuration at the west driveway entrance of the Food Lion shopping center along NC 24 (W. Corbett Avenue) to reduce conflict points and improve traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the upgrade and integration of eight (8) traffic signals along NC 24 (W. Corbett Avenue) into a coordinated closed-loop signal system would improve signal timing, reduce congestion, enhance roadway efficiency, and support safer travel for all users; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) has reviewed these proposed improvements and determined they are consistent with local and regional transportation safety goals and has expressed support for advancing these projects through continued coordination among local, state, and regional partners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Swansboro, North Carolina, that the Town hereby expresses its support for the transportation safety projects and initiatives identified along NC 24 (W. Corbett Avenue); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Swansboro supports continued collaboration with JUMPO, NCDOT, and other stakeholders to pursue planning, funding, and implementation of these improvements to enhance safety and mobility within the community.
