SERVICE CARS, TAXICABS AND DELIVERY TRUCKS

§ 71.40 PERMIT REQUIRED.

No person, firm or corporation shall operate or cause to be operated within the city any of the following classes of motor vehicles without first obtaining, from the City Secretary, a permit to do so:

- (A) Service cars or taxicabs which carry passengers for hire; or
- (B) Commercial trucks which are used for the purpose of delivering laundry, clothes, bread, ice, dairy products, petroleum products, bottled drinks, merchandise or any other commodity and ambulances.

§ 71.41 PERMIT AND CERTIFICATE.

When the City Clerk issues the permit, as provided for in §71.40, he or she shall furnish the applicant or owner with a certificate for each vehicle showing that all of the provisions of this subchapter have been fulfilled. This certificate shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the vehicle, or carried in a holder within the vehicle so that it will be accessible for inspection at all times. Failure to carry the certificate shall be deemed sufficient cause for revocation of the permit for that particular vehicle to operate on the streets of the city.
