

RESOLUTION NO. 23 FOR 2021

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE STATE GAS TAX AND PUBLIC TRANSIT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Sweet Home City Council adopted the 2020-2021 budget on June 23, 2020, and;

WHEREAS, the Sweet Home City Council reviewed and authorized the purchase of a new street sweeper, and;

WHEREAS, the Sweet Home City Council adopted Resolution No. 28 for 2020 establishing an inter fund loan to purchase the street sweeper, and;

WHEREAS, the staff at the Sweet Home Community Center also operate the Linn Shuttle program, and;

WHEREAS, the Linn Shuttle program obtained unanticipated grants during the fiscal year related to the COVID-19 pandemic for mitigation efforts, and;

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law requires a public hearing for any supplemental budget which adds ten (10) percent or more in expenditure authority, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 28, 2021 to hear testimony over the proposed supplemental budget, and;

WHEREAS, the Council has heard public testimony on the topic of the supplemental budget.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF SWEET HOME adopts a supplemental budget authorizing \$206,186 to be used to purchase the replacement street sweeper and \$250,000 in additional revenue and expenditure authority to cover grant expenses associated with the Linn Shuttle program.

This resolution shall take effect upon its approval and passage.
