Attached is our mostly completed application. Here are more notes on the following incomplete areas: insurance, liquor license, and vendors.

Insurance: Blake @ Keesecker Insurance is working on the policy and even if we paid for it today or tomorrow, we will not see the paperwork until next week. We will forward it just as soon as we get it.

Liquor License: Similar to the Oregon Jamboree Festival, Carroll Unruh at Oregon Beverage Services has to take care of this for us, since he is the designated vendor. He will give it to the SH Police Chief who will approve it and then send it off to you. I will continue to follow up regarding this as well.

Vendors: As we discussed on the phone, this is still very much in flux. We had one cancel on us and we are still recruiting 1-3 more. I included what we have so far and am working with Linn County Health Department as well so they know who will need to have inspections. They also have a list of our food vendors.

In the application/package, the last three pages have our schedule, a brief FAQ's sheet with the information you can also find our website, and a full map with vendor & tent placement.
