## **RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 2022**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE STATE GAS TAX FUND

WHEREAS, the Sweet Home City Council adopted the 2021-2022 budget on June 22, 2021, and; WHEREAS, the Police Department's expenditure authority was adopted at \$3,515,963, and; WHEREAS, property tax revenue was budgeted at \$3,242,132 for the fiscal year, and; WHEREAS, forecasted property tax revenue the City is to receive is \$3,414,951, and; WHEREAS, the Justice Center, which houses the Police Department and Municipal Court, was constructed in 2000, and; WHEREAS, the building's existing access control system was installed during construction, and; WHEREAS, the access control system is beyond its current life and support, and; WHEREAS, the access control system provides extensive security for the Justice Center, and; WHEREAS, a supplemental budget is necessary to replace the existing access control system using unanticipated revenue from property taxes. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF SWEET HOME adopts a supplemental budget authorizing \$75,000 to be used to replace the access control system at the Justice Center located at 1950 Main Street using additional property tax revenues forecast for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. This resolution shall take effect upon its approval and passage. PASSED by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2022. Mayor
