

### **10.08.030 PROHIBITED PARKING**

In addition to provisions of the motor vehicle laws of Oregon prohibiting parking, no person shall park:

- A. A vehicle upon any bridge, viaduct or other elevated structure used as a street or within a street tunnel in the city, unless marked or indicated otherwise;
- B. A vehicle in any alley, except to load or unload persons or materials not to exceed 20 consecutive minutes in any two-hour period;
- C. A vehicle upon any street for the principal purpose of:
  - 1. Displaying the vehicle for sale;
  - 2. Washing, greasing or repairing the vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency;
  - 3. Selling merchandise from the vehicle, except in a duly established market place or when so authorized or licensed under the ordinances of this city; and/or
  - 4. Storage or as junkage or dead storage for more than 24 hours.
- D. A vehicle upon any parkway, except where specifically authorized;
- E. A vehicle upon any street, except an alley, for more than 48 hours;
- F. A vehicle in violation of authorized signage or barrier; and
- G. Vehicles that are parked in violation of subsections C.4. and E. of this section may be towed and disposed of as if the vehicle were an "abandoned vehicle", under O.R.S. 819.110 to O.R.S. 819.215, inclusive. Vehicles that are parked in violation of subsection F. may be towed and disposed of as if the vehicle were a "traffic hazard" under O.R.S. 819.120 to O.R.S. 819.215 inclusive with notice being given within 48 hours. The persons involved shall have all the rights and duties created thereby. This authority to tow and dispose of the vehicle is in addition to any other authority to tow or dispose of vehicles.
