

**ORDINANCE NO. 939**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF TENINO, WASHINGTON,  
REPEALING TENINO MUNICIPAL CODE 14.36.200**

**WHEREAS**, on February 10, 2010, the Tenino City Council under Ordinance No. 773 approved a police department investigative fund; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of the investigative fund disclosed the cash to not be present in the police department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tenino City Council does not deem replenishment of the \$3,000.00 investigative fund necessary; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TENINO,  
WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Tenino Municipal Code 14.36.200 shall hereby be repealed and the police department investigative fund is no more.

**ADOPTED** by the City Council of the City of Tenino, Washington, and approved by its Mayor, at a regularly scheduled open public meeting this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026.
