

ORDINANCE 905

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TENINO AMENDING THE TENINO MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 8.09 (FIREWORKS)

WHEREAS, Chapter 8.09 of the Tenino Municipal Code relating to fireworks was last amended by Ordinance 722, duly adopted by the Tenino City Council on June 13, 2006; and

WHEREAS, after two decades of conflict that has seen many disabled veterans, some of whom suffer from PTSD, choosing Tenino as their place of residence; and

WHEREAS, the aging population of many of Tenino's long-term residents no longer appreciate the noise and mess associated with fireworks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TENINO, WASHINGTON, that the following changes are made to the Tenino Municipal Code, amending Chapter 8.09, as follows:

Section 1. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Tenino, Washington, and the sections of the code and this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish that intention.

Section 2. § 8.09.040 – Dates and times fireworks may be used and discharged, is hereby replaced in its entirety by a new § 8.09.040 as follows:

§ 8.09.040 – Dates and times fireworks may be used and discharged

- A. 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 3;
- B. 10:00 a.m. to midnight on July 4;
- C. 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 5; and
- D. 6:00 p.m. on December 31 to 1:00 a.m. on January 1.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after publication as required by law.
