

Agreement Between

City of Tenino

And

VFW Post #5878

Veteran Monument

PURPOSE:

This Agreement establishes the responsibilities for the replacement monument that was used to note the names of all the Veterans who served in all services during WW2 and were residents of Tenino. The new monument will honor all Tenino residents who served in any service from 1913 to 2012 (the "Monument").

RESPONSIBILITIES OF ENTITIES:

CITY:

1. The city will prepare the site for installation of a gravel base and will compact the soil to the best of its ability with available equipment for installation of the Monument.
2. The city will supply water and power during of the Monument.

VETERAN COMMITTEE:

The Veteran Committee shall:

1. Design and Engineer the Monument and obtain all proper permits for construction and installation of the same.
2. Provide gravel for the base are required.
3. Assure all volunteers/workers have executed Hold Harmless Agreements and delivered the same to the City.
4. The Veteran Committee will be responsible for all construction costs. Frank Hicks has pledged that his estate will ensure all financial costs will be met if VFW is not able to raise the funds necessary to complete the design, engineering, and

installation of the Monument (the “Project”) in a timely manner. The Project, once commenced, will proceed without delay except for delays caused by shortage of materials, weather, or other circumstances outside the control of the Veteran Committee.

5. Upkeep and maintenance of the Monument will be the responsibility of VFW Post #5878 until November 2029, at which time Upkeep and maintenance will be assumed by the City of Tenino.
6. VFW Post #5878 will give written notice to the City at least 2 weeks before the start of the installation and will coordinate with the Director of Public Works to coordinate any work required to be performed by the City.
7. Upon completion of the Project, ownership of the Veteran Monument will be given to the City.
