

RESOLUTION 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TENINO AMENDING RESOLUTION 2019-01, THE CITY OF TENINO “CITY OFFICIAL HANDBOOK”

WHEREAS, Resolution 2019-01, establishing the City of Tenino “City Official Handbook” was duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Tenino on May 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The City of Tenino “City Official Handbook” was last revised in May of 2019; and

WHEREAS, both federal and state law have made changes since May of 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, are aware that the “City Official Handbook” will need to be revised as necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TENINO, WASHINGTON, do resolve to amend Resolution 2019-01 “City Official Handbook” as follows:

Section I. Chapter 7, Page 11, Section II., A.

In accordance with the federal and state holidays, June 19th, also known as “Juneteenth,” will be added to the list of holidays that are recognized by the City.

Section II. Chapter 7, Page 11, Section II., C. shall read as follows:

Non-exempt regular full-time employees will be paid an additional one-half times their regular rate of pay for any time worked on a holiday.
