



Sec. 28-91 (c) (1): *Number of off-street parking spaces required.* In all districts there shall be provided at such time any building or structure is erected, enlarged, or increased in capacity, off-street parking spaces for automobiles in accordance with the following requirements:

Dwelling. One and one-half (1½) parking spaces for each separate dwelling unit within the structure.

Sec. 28-91 (c) (12): *Manufactured homes, mobile homes, and recreational vehicles.* Two (2) off-street parking spaces shall be provided for each mobile home, manufactured home, recreational vehicle, and temporary secondary dwelling units. The two (2) required off-street parking spaces shall be located behind the front yard setback line. Garages, carports, and parking pads shall be utilized in complying with the off-street parking requirement.

There is currently no ordinance prohibiting the parking of automobiles in front of the front build line or in the front yard of a property.
