Mayor Allen Brown called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

### **CONSENT**

Assistant Mayor Harris requested item 5. Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an engineering contract with A.L. 4. Resolution No. 2025-103 authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Plummer Associates, Inc. for the development of a hydraulic analysis of the sewer collection system and a sewer collection system master plan serving the Cities of Texarkana, Texas and Texarkana, Arkansas. (TWU) Executive Director Gary Smith

## **REGULAR**

5. Resolution No. 2025-104 authorized the City Manager to enter into an engineering contract with A.L. Franks Engineering for the Design of 2025 Street Bond Rehab Projects: E. 24th Street, E. 48th Street and Oats Street. (PWD) Interim Public Works Director Tracie Lee

6. Resolution No. 2025-105 authorized the approval for a one-time ten percent (10%) increase for all employees in the Arkansas Retirement Plan and an ongoing three percent (3%) COLA for retirees in the Texarkana Water Utilities Arkansas Retirement Plan. (TWU) Executive Director Gary Smith

After a brief discussion, the motion to adopt the resolution made by Director Roberts, Seconded by Director Hollibush.

The motion carried 7-0 and the Mayor declared the resolution adopted.

7. Ordinance No. 29-2025 approved the Police Department Fee Schedule for the Training Facility and Training Course. (TAPD) Chief Ed Chattaway

After a brief discussion, the ordinance was read for the first time in title form.

Motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on its second reading in abbreviated form made by Director Brewer, Seconded by Director Smith.

Voting Yea: Mayor Brown, Director Roberts, Assistant Mayor Harris, Director Hollibush, Director Brewer, Director Jewell, and Director Smith.

The motion carried 7-0 and the ordinance was read the second time in abbreviated form.

Motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on its third and final reading in abbreviated form made by Director Smith, Seconded by Director Hollibush.

Voting Yea: Mayor Brown, Director Roberts, Assistant Mayor Harris, Director Hollibush, Director Brewer, Director Jewell, and Director Smith.

The motion carried 7-0 and the ordinance was read the third time in abbreviated form.

Motion to adopt the ordinance made by Director Smith, Seconded by Director Roberts.

Mayor Brown asked if anyone would like to speak for or against this ordinance.

No one came forward.

Voting Yea: Mayor Brown, Director Roberts, Assistant Mayor Harris, Director Hollibush, Director Brewer, Director Jewell, and Director Smith.

The motion carried 7-0 and the Mayor declared the ordinance adopted.

*The applicant requests an emergency clause. An emergency clause requires a separate and distinct vote of the board and is valid only if there is a two-thirds vote of approval by the board. (Hdbk. Const. Amend 7)*

Motion to enact the emergency clause made by Director Roberts, Seconded by Director Brewer.

Mayor Brown asked if anyone would like to speak for or against the emergency clause.

No one came forward.

Voting Yea: Mayor Brown, Director Roberts, Director Hollibush, Director Brewer, Director Jewell, and Director Smith.

Voting Nay: Assistant mayor Harris.

The motion carried 6-1 and the Mayor declared the emergency clause enacted.

8. Resolution No. 2025-106 approved the FY2026 Budget. (ADMIN) City Manager Tyler Richards

After a brief discussion, the motion to adopt the resolution made by Director Hollibush, Seconded by Director Brewer.

Voting Yea: Mayor Brown, Director Roberts, Assistant Mayor Harris, Director Hollibush, Director Brewer, Director Jewell, and Director Smith.

The motion carried 7-0 and the Mayor declared the resolution adopted.
