- I want to commend our staff and volunteers for helping us have another successful Blessing of the Fleet. We had a wonderful turn out and already have ideas how to make it even better for next year.
- The transition from United Community Bank to BankSouth is coming to a close. Most accounts have all been transferred and we are now putting funds into the new bank.
- We are still in process with our FEMA reps to receive relief funding from Hurricane Helene.
- We are in the process of applying for the LRA grant to help pay for the striping on Whatley Ave.
- Renovations continue for Nellie Johnson Park and Honey Park. We have ordered the new basketball goals for Nellie Johnson and are researching swing sets. Our staff has collected all of the quotes for the new playground equipment to be installed at Honey Park.
