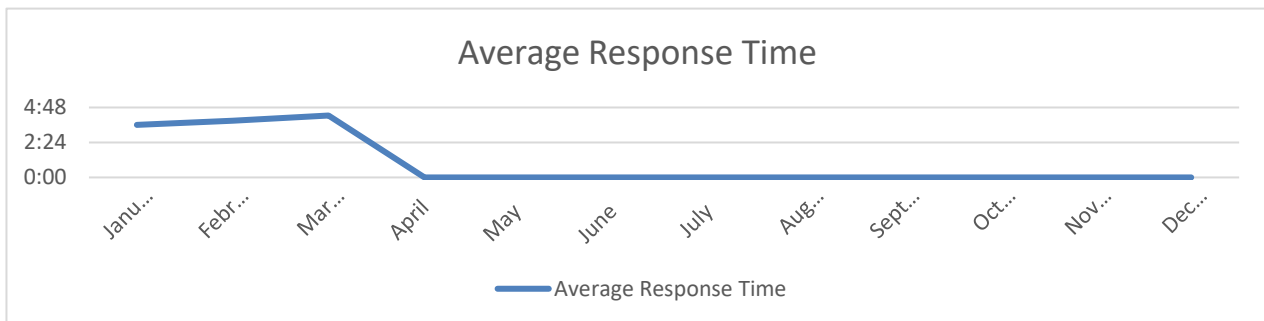
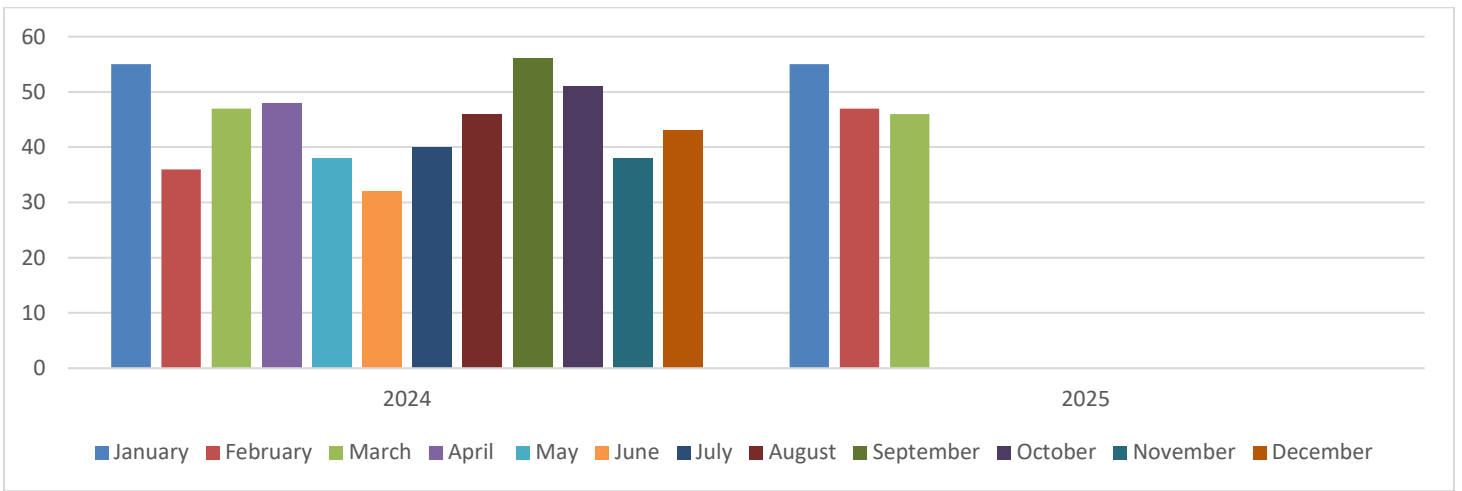

All Hurst (Extrication Tools) Completed their yearly Service. All units in service.

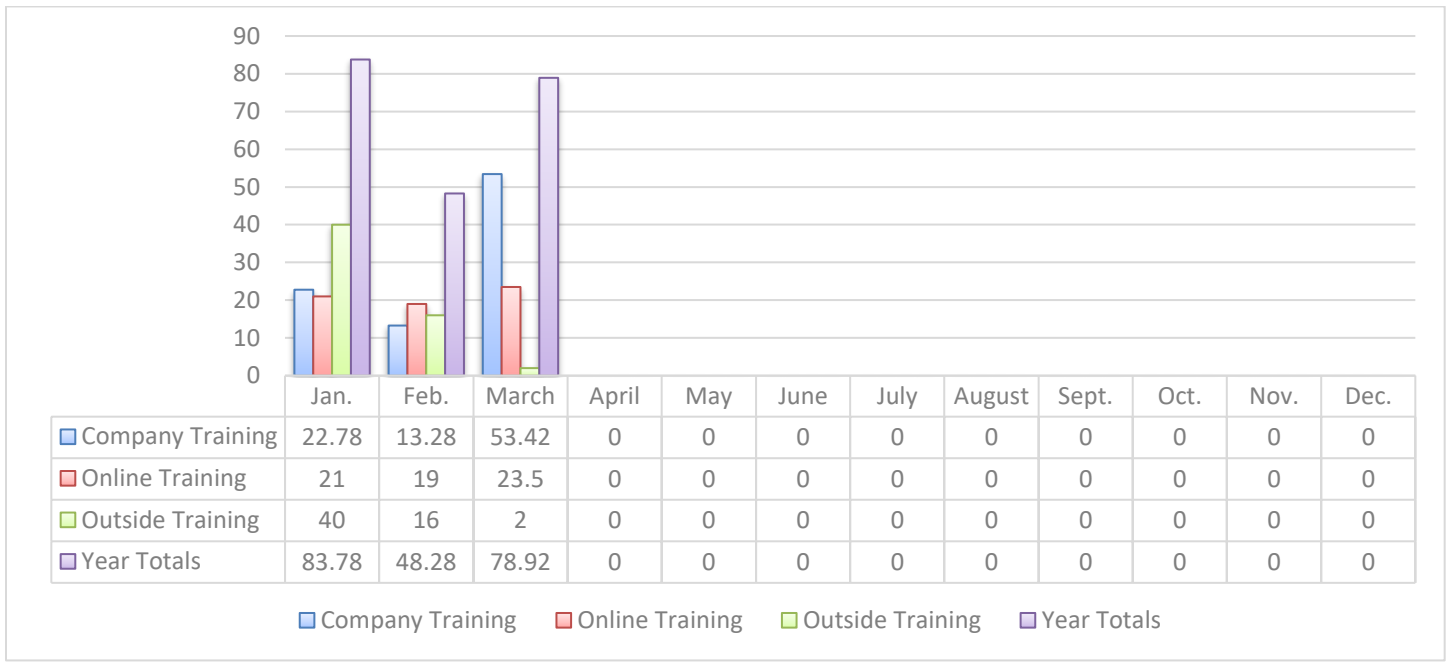
