**A PROCLAMATION**

**“VETERAN’S DAY”**

**WHEREAS**, we are pleased and honored that the Town of Thunderbolt has joined together again this year to pay tribute on this day to the dedicated veterans who have served this great nation with such distinction, both in peace time and in war; and

**WHEREAS**, Veterans Day began as Armistice Day, a holiday commemorating the end of World War I on November 11, 1918, and was established as a national holiday by presidential proclamation and congressional resolution in 1954; and

**WHEREAS**, In the City of Savannah we have over 30,000 veterans including 215 in the Town of Thunderbolt who have served our country; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Thunderbolt acknowledges the tremendous sacrifices made by these individuals and their families, and appreciates the enduring spirit of service they have instilled in our community; and

**WHEREAS**, we honor the legacy of our veterans who have served both at home and abroad, recognizing that their sacrifice have played an essential role in upholding the core values of our nation; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR DANA WILLIAMS & COUNCIL**, do hereby call upon all of our citizens to observe Tuesday, November 11, 2025, as Veterans Day. On that day let us solemnly remember the sacrifices of all those who fought so valiantly, on the seas, in the air, and on foreign shores, to preserve our heritage of freedom, and let us reconsecrate ourselves to the task of promoting and enduring peace so that their efforts shall not have been in vain.
