Savannah Police Department had an armed bank robbery and the suspect fled in to Thunderbolt's area, where he carjacked, a vehicle using a handgun. Thunderbolt officers along with Savannah PD set up a large perimeter and was able to locate, and take that suspect into custody. A deputy sheriff's K-9 unit was called and assisted with finding the firearm that was used in the robbery and the carjacking. Fortunately, no injuries occurred during this incident, and the suspect later confessed to the crimes committed at the Bank of America on Victory Drive and the carjacking. Work like this speaks volumes for the type of training, experience, and the work relationship that we have with our fellow agencies.
