“A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF SAVANNAH’S VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN & AFFIRMING THE TOWN OF THUNDERBOLT’S COMMITMENT TO SAFE STREETS FOR ALL”

WHEREAS, the Town of Thunderbolt is committed to protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its residents, visitors, businesses, and all users of the transportation system; and

WHEREAS, transportation safety is a regional concern that transcends municipal boundaries and requires collaboration among local governments, transportation agencies, public safety officials, schools, businesses, and community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah adopted a Vision Zero Action Plan with the goal of eliminating traffic fatalities and serious injuries while increasing safe, healthy, and equitable mobility for all roadway users; and

WHEREAS, the Vision Zero philosophy recognizes that traffic fatalities and serious injuries are preventable, that human error is inevitable, and that transportation systems should be designed to minimize the likelihood that mistakes result in death or severe injury; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Thunderbolt shares transportation corridors, pedestrian routes, bicycle facilities, transit connections, and economic ties with the City of Savannah and neighboring communities throughout Chatham County; and

WHEREAS, residents of Thunderbolt regularly travel throughout the region for employment, education, recreation, healthcare, and commerce, making roadway safety a matter of regional importance; and

WHEREAS, safe and accessible streets, sidewalks, intersections, bicycle facilities, transit connections, and traffic-calming measures improve quality of life, support economic vitality, encourage healthy lifestyles, and provide equitable access for persons of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Thunderbolt supports transportation planning principles that prioritize safety, accessibility, mobility, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance while promoting responsible growth and community connectivity; and

WHEREAS, collaboration with regional partners can strengthen efforts to improve pedestrian safety, bicycle safety, traffic operations, speed management, public education, data collection, and infrastructure investment;

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, I, MAYOR DANA WILLIAMS & THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THUNDERBOLT COUNCIL, do hereby formally express its support for the City of Savannah’s Vision Zero Action Plan and support the consideration of roadway, sidewalk, bicycle, traffic-calming, accessibility and pedestrian safety improvements that contribute to reducing crashes and enhancing mobility within Thunderbolt and throughout the surrounding region.
