- Our Sustainability Corner is up and running. We have glass recycling, compost, and cardboard recycling open to the public. The Sustainability Corner is located just behind Town Hall.

- Our staff has been hard at work transitioning all of our finances over to our new BankSouth Bank.
- Our staff is in the process of updating our right of way ordinances and Permit Processes in accordance with GMA regulations.
- We are talking with Senator Ossoff's team to help us obtain support and potential funding assistance with our Force Main replacement project.
- We have just applied for a Hazard Mitigation Grant to help fund the replacement of the generator we have at Town Hall.
