SUBJECT: Monthly Report for February 2025

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

The two new police vehicles are here, and one has already been equipped. The other one is scheduled to get equipped as soon as all of the equipment arrives which will hopefully be the first week of March.

The new firearms have been issued and all officers have transitioned from the Glock .45 caliber to the new Glock .9mm. On average, all officer's qualification scores were 20 points higher using the optic, compared to last year's qualification scores without the optic.

Sergeant Charles Wilson (CJ) went to the Georgia Public Safety Training Center in Forsyth Ga. the third week of this month and has successfully passed his Instructor Level 1 course. This means he can perform general training through Georgia P.O.S.T., training that we ordinarily would not be able to do in house. That particular class is one that has a pretty high attrition rate so this was a tremendous accomplishment for Sergeant Wilson and for the police department as a whole.
