**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF THORNTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS  
TITLE 1, ADMINISTRATIVE,  
BY AMENDING SECTION 1-5A-1, REGULAR MEETINGS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Thornton is a Home Rule Municipality within the purview of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and the said Village, therefore, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 1, Chapter 5, Article A, Section 1 provides for regular and committee meetings, and

**WHEREAS**, The President and Village Board wish to change the time of both meetings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Thornton, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Title 1, Chapter 5, Article A, Section 1 of the Code of the Village of Thornton shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1-5A-1. Regular and Committee meetings.

The committee meeting of the Village shall be held on the first and third Mondays of each month at the Thornton Village Hall, and shall convene at Six o'clock PM (6:00) P.M. The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village shall be held on the first and third Mondays of each month at the Thornton Village Hall, and shall convene at six-fifteen pm (6:15) PM or directly following the committee meeting. Both regular and committee meetings will be held on the following Tuesday in the event the meeting falls on a legal holiday. There shall be no meetings on the first Monday during the months of January and July, unless otherwise called by the village president or board of trustees.

**SECTION 2:** That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by law.

**SECTION 4:** That this Ordinance is authorized to be published in pamphlet form.
