

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD  
OF CONTRACTS WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING  
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6**

**WHEREAS**, there is an emergency condition with the boiler system in Borough Hall. One of the two boilers is no longer in service. This requires the immediate purchase of a new boiler as per the memorandum attached. The cost of the new boiler would be \$132,000; and

**WHEREAS**, provisions of NJSA 40A: 11-6 permit the Borough to award contracts without public bidding when an emergency affecting the health, welfare, and safety of the public requires the immediate performance of services; and

**WHEREAS**, Tom Neff, Borough Engineer has described the situation and declared this situation an emergency condition in the memo dated November 14, 2022 attached;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Tinton Falls that authorization be and is hereby given to award contracts for the purchase of a new boiler.
