Background:

This item is to Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Harris County Emergency Services District # 16 (ESD 16) for fleet maintenance services to enhance efficiency, reduce costs, and improve service reliability. This partnership is expected to generate budgetary savings by reducing expenditures on outsourced repairs, labor, and third-party service markups while providing a more stable maintenance budget. Additionally, leveraging the ESD’s expertise in maintaining public safety vehicles will result in faster turnaround times, minimizing downtime and ensuring the City’s fleet remains operational and mission-ready. The ESD’s familiarity with heavy fire apparatus, including personnel with manufacture certifications and experience, ensures that repairs meet the highest safety and performance standards, improving overall service quality. By consolidating maintenance services, the City benefits from improved coordination, proactive scheduling, and enhanced accountability, leading to an extended fleet lifespan and more reliable service delivery for the community.
