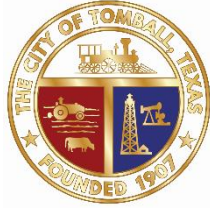


MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF TOMBALL, TEXAS

Adopt on Second Reading, Ordinance No. 2025-32, an Ordinance of the City of Tomball, Texas, Setting the Tax Levy of \$0.340940/\$100 of Value Assessed for the Year 2025 on All Taxable Real and Personal Property located in the City of Tomball, Texas; Providing for Penalty, Interest, and additional Penalty on Taxes not timely paid; and Providing other matters relating to the subject.

Motion was made by Council 4 Covington, Seconded by Council 3 Dunagin: "I move that property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.340940, which is effectively a 7.98 percent increase in the tax rate."
