Topic:

Consideration to approve a Professional Services Agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc. for Project Number 2023-10010, East Water Plant design for the City of Tomball, for the not-to-exceed amount of \$2,606,076, approve the expenditure of funds therefor, and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement. This project was included in the FY 2022-2023 budget.

Background:

The Waster Master Plan, completed in 2018, identified improvements to the City's water distribution system that would help the City serve anticipated future water demands. The recommendations included construction of a new water plant, referred to as the East Water Plant, to be located on the eastern side of the system along Hufsmith-Kohrville, generally between Mahaffey Road and Country Club Green Drive.

The proposed professional services agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc. (FNI) includes a scope of work to design and oversee construction of a new pump station, groundwater well, and ground storage tank for a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,606,076.

Funds for completing the proposed project were allocated in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget, as part of the Certificate of Obligation issuance.
