

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-25
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOMBALL
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE
2025 HARRIS COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Tomball recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within City of Tomball; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tomball has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has already been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM); and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in (local community) from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City of Tomball City Council demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Tomball:

Section 1. In accordance with the Charter of the City of Tomball, the City of Tomball adopts the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. This plan, approved by the community, may be edited or amended after submission for review, but will not require the community to re-adopt any further iterations. This only applies to this specific plan and does not absolve the community from updating the plan in 5 years.
