Discussion and possible action to designate Council members and city staff to an advisory committee to review possible options for municipal buildings at TEDC properties

Background:

During the TEDC 2026 Strategic Planning Workshop, the discussion included long-term options for addressing the City's municipal facility needs, including City Hall, the Police Department, and a potential community center. One concept that emerged was the creation of an advisory committee to evaluate potential uses of TEDC-owned properties, including the former First Baptist Church property and the South Live Oak property, for future municipal facilities.

The proposed advisory committee would review these properties, evaluate opportunities and constraints, and provide input regarding their potential to address the City's facility needs. It is proposed that the committee includes no more than two City Council members.

The TEDC Board intends to appoint two of its members to serve on the committee and may also recommend one representative from the Legacy Square Committee. After the TEDC Board makes its appointments, the proposed committee membership will be presented to the City Council for consideration and approval of the Council.
