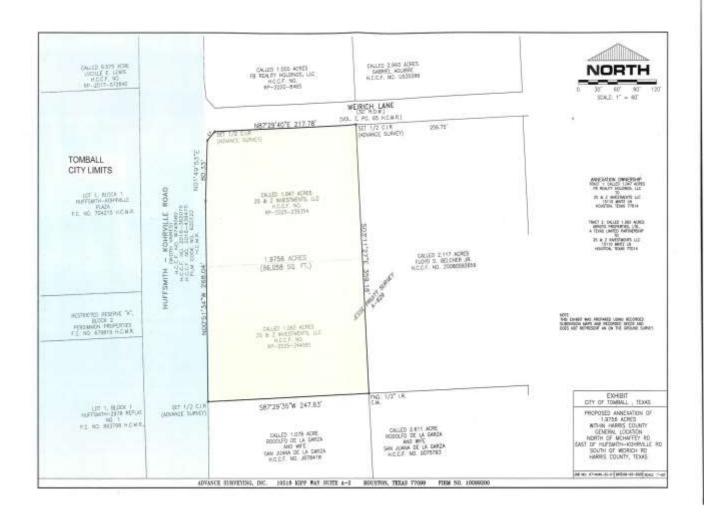
Introduction & Purpose

- Purpose: Request for full-purpose annexation of 1.9756 acres (two tracts) into the City of Tomball, Harris County, Texas
- Applicant: 2S&Z Investments LLC (Shan Ali, Owner)
- Location: North of Mahaffey Rd, east of Hufsmith-Korhville Rd, south of Weirich Rd
- Legal Basis: Chapter 43, Texas Local Government Code (Annexation Procedures)



Property Overview

- Tract 1: 1.047 acres (formerly FB Reality Holdings LLC, now 2S & Z Investments LLC)
- Tract 2: 1.062 acres (formerly Arotto Properties, Ltd., now 2S & Z Investments LLC)
- Combined Area: 1.9756 acres (86,058 sq. ft.)
- Legal Descriptions: Provided by Advance Surveying, Inc. (see Exhibit A)
- Proof of Ownership: Warranty deeds and metes & bounds included in application

Application Completeness & Compliance

- All Owners Consent: All property owners have signed the petition
- Contiguity: Property is contiguous and adjacent to current Tomball city limits
- ETJ Status: Located within Tomball's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ)
- No Agricultural/Timber/Wildlife Appraisal: Not appraised for those uses
- Waiver of Development Agreement: Owners waive right to a development agreement



Anticipated Development

- Current Use: Vacant land, no existing structures
- Platting: Applicant has contacted to Community Development for platting process
- Zoning: Request for zoning reclassification in conjunction with annexation (default is AG unless otherwise requested)
- Planned Use: 15,000 sq. ft. office/commercial building (masonry & steel), estimated value \$1.5 million



Municipal Service Plan

- General Services: Police, fire, solid waste, water, wastewater, gas, street maintenance, parks, and other city services to be provided at levels comparable to similar areas in Tomball
- Capital Improvements: No immediate proposed capital improvements planned; all infrastructure at cost of developer
- Service Extension Policy: Developers responsible for extending water, wastewater, and gas lines to city trunk lines



Council Actions & Staff Recommendation

Council Action:

- 1. Order a Public Hearing: As required by Texas Local Government Code, a public hearing must be held to receive comments on the proposed annexation
- 2. First Reading of Annexation Ordinance: Conduct the first reading of the ordinance to annex the subject property
- Post-Hearing Steps: Second reading and adoption of the ordinance at a subsequent meeting
- Staff Recommendation:
 - Proceed with ordering the public hearing and first reading of the annexation ordinance as the application is complete and compliant with Texas law and city policy
