Topic:

Consideration to approve an amendment to a professional services agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc. for on-call GIS, planning, and engineering services for an amount of \$50,000 (contract total not to exceed amount of \$100,000).

Background:

The City entered into a professional services agreement with Freese & Nichols, Inc. (FNI) for on-call GIS, planning, and engineering services earlier this year to supplement City staff efforts due to vacancies in key positions, and to provide on-call services for water and wastewater modeling. Through this contract, FNI has also provided both on-site and off-site support to City staff, including full-time onsite interim City Engineer services. The total not-to-exceed amount of the original contract was \$50,000.

Due to a continued vacancy in the City Engineer position and the ongoing needs for the City due to increased development, this contract amendment increases the total contract amount by \$50,000, for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000, and ensures assistance can be provided until September 30, or until an Assistant Public Works Director/City Engineer can be hired. This amendment will also allow FNI to continue providing supplemental on-call services for GIS updates and water and wastewater modeling even after positions are filled.
