REF: Request to Install Streetlights in the Hillendale Neighborhood and Kingston Court Area

Summary:

This is a request for the City Council to approve the installation of streetlights in the Hillendale Neighborhood and Kingston Court Area.

Background:

On September 15, 2009, the City Council adopted a petition process for the installation of streetlight within a neighborhood. The petition requires that at least 50% of the residents must sign the petition for new streetlights to be installed in a given area of the City. In February 2025, a petition was submitted by the residents of the Hillendale Neighborhood and Kingston Court requesting the installation of streetlights in this area.

Scott Tuttle, who lives at 7121 Kingston Road, was the lead petitioner for this request. Mr. Tuttle was able to secure the signatures of 48 residents out of 79 homes in the target area. These signatures represent over 50 percent of residents of this area which meets the requirements for the streetlight petition. The residents are requesting that streetlights be installed on the following streets:

Valley View Road
Kingston Road
Briar Cliff Road
Valley Circle

Kingston Court
Meadow Brook View Road
Arden Road
Unity Street from NC Hwy 62 to the Thomasville City Limits)

Attached are copies of the streetlight petitions and copies of the maps of showing the locations of those homeowners.

Recommendation:

Staff request that the City Council approve and move forward with the installation of streetlights in the Hillendale Neighborhood and Kingston Court Area.
