RESOLUTION 2025-54

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE AUTHORIZING
THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA
HIGHWAY PATROL FOR FUNDING FROM THE CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol (CHP), through the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP), provides funding to local law enforcement agencies to reduce and mitigate impaired driving impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Truckee Police Department submitted a grant application in February 2025 and was awarded grant funding in the amount of \$222,656.53 on June 13, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the awarded grant funds will enable the Town to enhance traffic safety through the purchase of equipment, specialized training for law enforcement staff, and dedicated traffic enforcement shifts; and

WHEREAS, the specific uses of the awarded grant funds include:

1. Acquisition of three solar-powered radar/message board trailers, equipped with radar feedback, traffic data collection capabilities, and mobile messaging for strategic deployment in high-risk speeding locations, public events, and emergency situations;
2. Specialized training, including Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) for six patrol officers and recertification for one Drug Abuse Recognition Expert (DRE), as well as funding for up to sixty-four dedicated traffic enforcement overtime shifts; and
3. Purchase of two BMW R 1300 RT motorcycles designed specifically for sustained traffic enforcement, offering superior reliability, reduced greenhouse gas emissions, compliance with stringent emissions standards, and optimal versatility and mobility; and

WHEREAS, the introduction of these motorcycles will enable existing Zero Motorcycles to return to their original intended role of trail monitoring and enforcement, thus reducing maintenance downtime and enhancing community trail safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to execute a grant agreement with the California Highway Patrol for funding from the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program in the amount of \$222,656.53.
2. The Town Manager, or their designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to implement and administer the grant agreement and related expenditures in accordance with this resolution
