**RESOLUTION 2025-52**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE  
SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF MEASURE G TO SUPPORT THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW LIBRARY IN TRUCKEE**

**WHEREAS**, in 2018, the Town of Truckee, Nevada County, and the Friends of the Truckee Library began strategic planning to construct a new Truckee Library; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2023, the Town of Truckee, Nevada County, and the Friends of the Truckee Library entered into an MOU for purposes of funding a total of \$1.5 million for initial phases of design and project development for a new Truckee Library; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2024, The Town of Truckee, Nevada County, and Placer County formed a joint powers authority (JPA) for purposes of constructing a new library at the Truckee River Regional Park; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2024, the Truckee Library JPA entered into agreements with the Truckee Donner Public Utility District, and the Truckee Donner Recreation and Park District to locate a new library adjacent to the Truckee River Regional Park on land owned by the Truckee Donner Public Utility District; and

**WHEREAS**, a new modern library facility that is sized to meet the community's current and future needs will be beneficial to all ages and economic groups in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, The new library will also be designed to serve as an emergency resource center to serve the community and its residents during natural disasters, extended power outages, and other events that impact community infrastructure and services; and

**WHEREAS**, The Friends of the Truckee Library have developed a three-part funding strategy to raise capital dollars for the construction of the new library that includes private fundraising, obtaining foundation and government grants, and passing a community wide bond measure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Truckee Library Joint Powers Authority Board of Directors unanimously voted on June 23, 2025 to place a community-wide bond measure on a special election that will occur on November 4, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Clerk Recorder has assigned the bond measure the identifier of Measure G which will ask voters the question of whether or not to implement a community-wide annual parcel assessment of 3 cents per square foot of building area for developed parcels, and \$29 per parcel for undeveloped parcels; and

**WHEREAS**, if the measure passes it will generate up to \$19 million towards construction of a new library; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

that the Truckee Town Council supports the passage of Measure G which is being proposed to Town of Truckee and portions of unincorporated Placer and Nevada County voters as part of the November 4, 2025 Special Election.
