Title: Bond Counsel Presentation: Stradling

Recommended Action: Accept the Presentation

<u>Discussion</u>: Pursuant to the JPA Agreement, the JPA is responsible for constructing and maintaining the Truckee Library.

In order to carry out this responsibility, the JPA is authorized to: issue revenue bonds and other forms of indebtedness as well as impose, levy, collect or cause to be collected, to receive and use sales taxes, parcel taxes, Mello Roos taxes, property taxes, special taxes, or any other type of tax or assessment, as authorized by law.

The steps needed to issue revenue bonds require the expertise and guidance of outside bond counsel.

Stradling, existing bond counsel to the County of Nevada, will present on the next steps and critical path timeline to bringing a bond measure to the voters at a future date.
